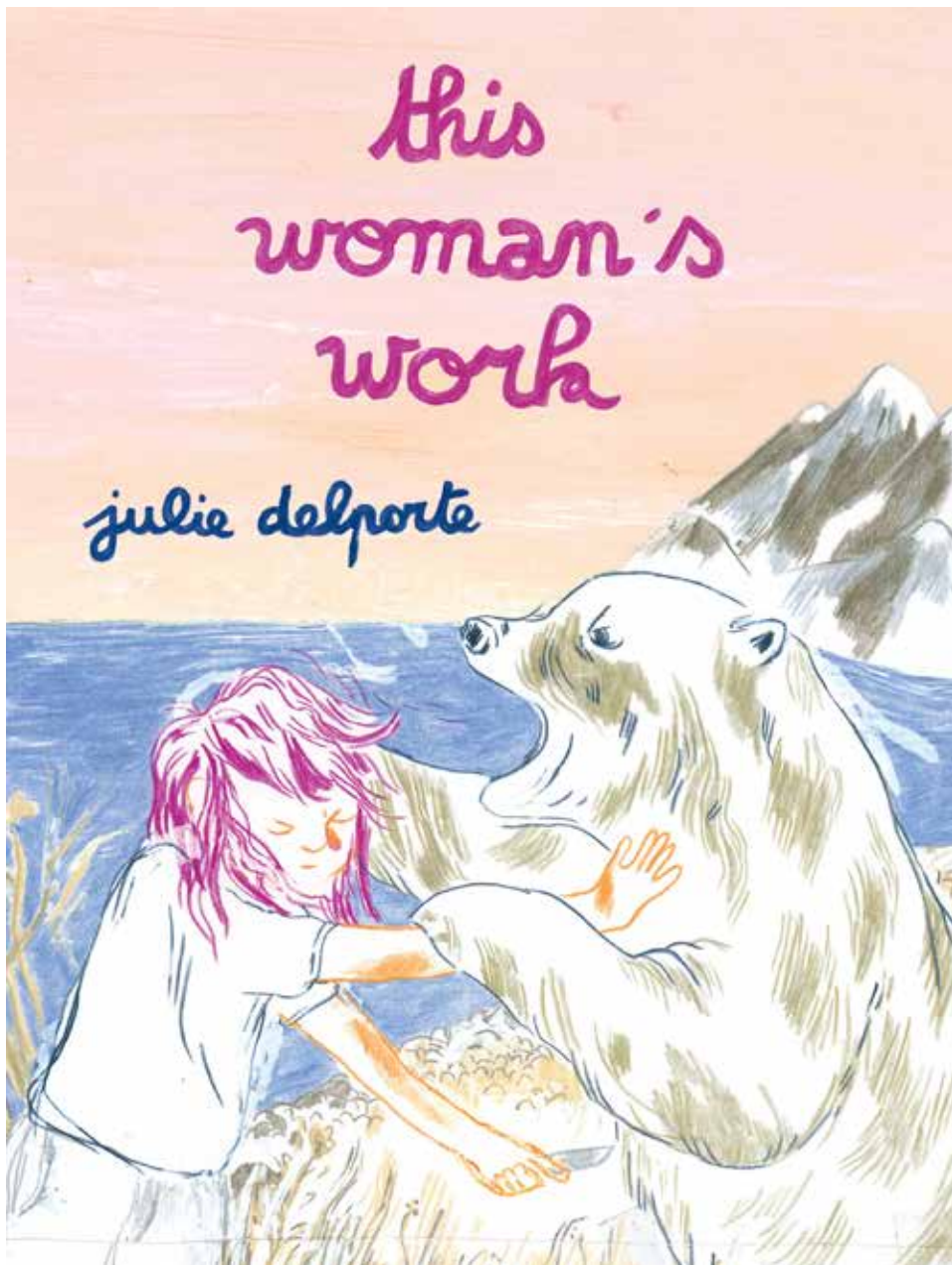


Drawing Gender: Women and French-language Comics
